We are inviting young adults to learn the skills of holy and healthy disruption. Holy Disruption is an exploration of faith, organizing and the school-to-prison pipeline.

Holy Disruption is a faith based social justice education intensive sponsored by United Methodist Women. It is a five month commitment with a monthly average of 15 hours per week in study and class time. This opportunity is open to young adults ages 19-35. All travel and accommodations will be covered by United Methodist Women.

ONLINE LEARNING
