The Legacy Fund: Endowing the future of mission for the next 150 years.

United Methodist Women will be celebrating 150 years of mission in 2019. We have been given a strong foundation by our fore mothers. Their wise financial planning has left us a legacy that continues to change lives in communities down the street and around the world.

So while, in the 21st century, we celebrate the past 150 years of mission work, we also need to prepare for the next 150. We can almost imagine the challenges our daughters and granddaughters will face as they take on the legacy of United Methodist Women. We need to prepare a firm foundation so they are free to address the challenges of their time head on and affect real change.

And to do this, we've started an endowment called *The Legacy Fund*.

The Legacy Fund is a forward-thinking permanent endowment with income dedicated to strengthening United Methodist Women. The total program of United Methodist Women is mission. United Methodist Women service, advocacy and transformative learning opportunities equip members to be agents of change and promotes the empowerment of women that is essential to address the root causes of so many conditions harming women, children and youth.

The Legacy Fund will provide the tools, resources and personnel to distribute United Methodist Women's grants, scholarships, coordinate with mission personnel and support technological updates like operating systems for data and communication, and more.

Ensuring a regular source of support for these core expenses will free future generations to budget Mission Giving to connect directly with the needs of women, children and youth. It will allow our successors to promote Mission Giving in a totally different way.

And we'd like to invite you to be a part of this legacy as we begin our 5 year celebration of the 150th anniversary of the organization.

The campaign officially launched at Assembly 2014, will be celebrated at Assembly 2018, and will culminate in 2019, the 150th year.

The celebration of the 150th anniversary will involve the organization at all levels, and will raise contributions to The Legacy Fund to *permanently* sustain our ongoing mission with women, children, and youth.

Together we can make it happen.

Frequently Asked Questions about The Legacy Fund / 150th Anniversary Celebration:



What is The Legacy Fund?

- A key element of the 150th Anniversary celebration in 2019.
- A designated fund (endowment) of the national office of United Methodist Women. (Only interest can be expended.)

Our South Carolina Every Member Legacy Fund Goal:

That every member of United Methodist Women make a gift to The Legacy Fund of at least \$18.69 per year, over and above her Pledge to Mission, for five years (2015 - 2019).

What is the purpose of The Legacy Fund?

- To assure the continuation of ministries with women, children and youth, worldwide, into the next 150 years.
- To enable United Methodist Women to respond more adequately to new and emerging needs.
- To minimize the risk of severe budget fluctuation in years of recession, regional financial crisis, or change in giving by the membership.

How will the funds be used?

• The total program of United Methodist Women is mission. Interest from The Legacy Fund will be added to Mission Giving funds to formulate the national budget of United Methodist Women. (Mission Giving is the largest source of that budget which includes grants to National Mission Institutions such as the Bethlehem Center in Columbia, Killingsworth, Rural Mission, Spartanburg Methodist College, international programs and projects, program resource production, training, and more.)

Why should I give to The Legacy Fund?

- The Legacy Fund is OUR special anniversary gift to future United Methodist Women members and ministries.
- To "pass on" the legacy we have inherited. "To stake out our legacy for future generations." (January 2015 response, page 3). Isabella Thoburn College, Lucknow, India, is an outgrowth of the work of the first missionary of our organization. The College motto is: "We Receive to Give."
- Because we believe in the PURPOSE of United Methodist Women and want our daughters, granddaughters, nieces and friends to share our sense of meaningful "sisterhood."
- To be part of the joyous celebration in 2019 culminating 150 years of ministry.

How does the money get to the National Office?

Gifts are given to the local treasurer who sends the Legacy Fund money and commitment cards to the District treasurer
following regular procedures. There is a line on the local treasurer Remittance form for The Legacy Fund.

Does a Legacy Fund gift count for the individual or Unit Pledge to Mission Giving?

 No. This is a special additional gift to celebrate the 150th anniversary. In fact, it is critical that we sustain and even increase our Pledge to Mission Giving during this five year campaign; the needs have never been greater.

How do we give? Annually? All at once? What about non-cash gifts?

- Each person can determine her schedule of giving; any schedule is appropriate.
- Non-cash gifts of stock, property, life insurance, etc., can be given through the United Methodist Women National Office. Contact the Treasurer's office at 212-870-3740.



How do I get a Legacy 150 pin?

When you turn in a Commitment Card, you will receive a pin at your district annual meeting.

 At the top of the page, you will be asked to provide your church's name. Click on the dropdown menu in the CHURCH, DISTRICT, CONFERENCE box. Then, enter three (3) or more letters of your church's name. As you type, options for your church appear below. Choose the option that has your church, district, and conference.



2. By selecting your church from the list, the boxes for **CHURCH NAME**, **DISTRICT NAME**, and **CONFERENCE NAME** will automatically populate. Verify the information is correct. Then, enter the name of your UMW unit in the **UNIT NAME** box, as this may be different from your church's name.



- 3. Click on the **JURISDICTION** box. Your jurisdiction should automatically appear. Verify that it is accurate.
- 4. Enter the street address for your church in the CHURCH ADDRESS box. Enter the city where your church is located in the CITY box. Choose the state where your church is located using the dropdown menu in the STATE box. Enter the zip code for your church in the ZIP CODE box.





5. Choose the type of UMW unit from the dropdown menu in the **UNIT TYPE** box. The most common response will be 'Local'.

Number of New Members Appea


Members Lost by Death or Other Reasons




