Youth: Grades 6-12 attending Revolution 2016

Timing:

A contest entry form, photo, and description must be turned in by January 15th, 2016. Entrants will model their design at Revolution (Jan 29-31, 2016)

How to Enter:

Step 1: Register for Revolution 2016: www.scmyp.org/revolution

Step 2: Visit www.ImagineNoMalaria.org or www.INM.UMCSC.org to learn about the United Methodist efforts to end deaths from malaria through Imagine No Malaria.

Step 3: Using the information you learned about Imagine No Malaria, design a wearable garment using "nets" (tulle) as the main material, but please incorporate and/or use other materials into your design so that it is not see-through.

Step 4: By January 15, 2016 after reading and agreeing to the Official Rules, fill out a contest entry form, include photos (up to 5 pictures may be included), a description of your creation, and tell us how Imagine No Malaria inspired your design.

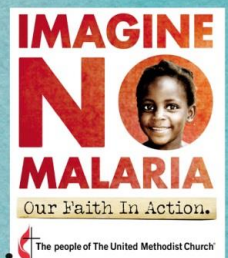

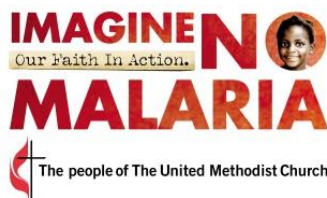
