Dr. F. Douglas Powe

Reverend Dr. F. Douglas Powe, Jr. is the James C. Logan Professor of Evangelism and Urban Ministry at Wesley, funded in part by the Foundation for Evangelism as an E. Stanley Jones professorship in evangelism. Dr. Powe's research has focused on the topics of evangelistic theology and practices, Pan-Methodism, and the Black church. Dr. Powe is the author of many books and articles, most recently, New Wine, New Wineskins: How African American Congregations Can Reach New Generations (Nashville: Abingdon Press, 2012), and Just-us or Justice: Moving Toward a Pan-Methodist Theology (Nashville: Abingdon Press, 2009). Additionally, two new books will be published in 2014 and 2015, respectively; Religion-Political Narratives in America: From Martin Luther King, Jr. through Jeremiah Wright, a book co-authored with Johnny Hill and Angela Sims, and NSFC (Not Safe for Church): The Ten Commandments for Reaching New Generations, co-authored with Jasmine Smothers.



Dr. Robin Dease

The Reverend Dr. Robin Dease is the District Superintendent of the Hartsville District. Dr. Dease earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Claflin University in early childhood education. With a Master of Divinity and a Doctor of Ministry in stewardship from Wesley Theological Seminary, Washington, D.C., Dease joined the S.C. Conference in 1998 and was ordained an elder in 2001. She first served as pastor of Wesley United Methodist Church, Johns Island (1998-2008), followed by John Wesley UMC, Greenville (2008-2012). Each of these congregations experienced new growth and vitality under her leadership. In 2012, Dr. Dease returned to her alma mater, Claflin University, to serve as the Chair of the Department of Religion. Previously, she served as adjunct professor in the Department of Religion. When invited by Bishop Jonathan Holston to serve as a member of the cabinet, Dr. Dease offered, "I am humbled and most grateful for the opportunity to serve in such an awesome way," Dease said. "I pray that through my ministry and service, the church's mission will be the driving factor for all I do."
