Spring Board Meeting, April 2023 was held in Zanesville, Ohio. The workshop entitled "Conflict Transformation" was led by Wendy Lybarger, Missional Specialist for the West Ohio Conference. This presentation is available on our Facebook page. The Board awarded \$2250 in hunger and poverty grants.

Fall Board Meeting, October 2023 was held virtually. UMAMN board meeting: The workshop entitled: "Building Bridges of Hope: The Role of the rural churches in Building Recovery Ecosystems" was led by Rev. Matthew Johnson, Director of Faith-Based Initiatives for the Fletcher Group. The Board awarded \$500 in hunger and poverty grants.

2023 Hunger and Poverty Grants served 200 children (weekly while schools are in session), 360 seniors, and 130 families: The goal of UMAMN is to provide support to ministries that address systemic causes of poverty, hunger, racism, and other social issues in the region. (Engaging in ministry with the poor) Three Hunger and Poverty grants were awarded. These projects focus on poverty issues in the region where resources are normally not provided for by government or local agencies. UMAMN strives to fund projects that fill the gap in impoverished areas and underserved populations.
