COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

<u>Basic</u> – This course is foundational for all courses in Lay Servant Ministries. Participants are encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in their discipleship.

<u>Youth Basic</u> – This course covers the same content as regular Basic but will be tailored to teen participants.

For the Common Good – Discovering and Using Your Spiritual Gifts (new course) - This course offers a scriptural understanding of spiritual gifts as always given "for the common good." By helping participants identify and link their gifts, abilities, and sense of calling, laity will learn the powerful connection between spiritual gifts and vocational discernment in the context of the mission of their local church. They will also learn how to make spiritual gifts discernment a part of their congregation's culture and commitment to equip mission-focused leaders who make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. This course satisfies spiritual gifts for Certified Lay Speaker candidates.

<u>Life Together in the United Methodist Connection (Polity)</u> – This course gives participants an overview of the structure and organization on The United Methodist Church. A copy of the Book of Discipline is recommended for this course (instructions for accessing it online will be given in class). This course is required for Certified Lay Speakers candidates.

<u>Sacraments: Means of Grace</u> – This course focuses on the key insights of the Rev. Beth Galbreath regarding the two books on our sacramental life: *By Water and the Spirit* (Baptism) and *This Holy Mystery* (Communion), by the late Gayle Carlton Felton. This course combines content from the separate online courses on Baptism and Communion that are available at https://beadisciple.com/.

You <u>must</u> participate in all 10 hours of classroom contact time to receive a certificate. Lay Servants must complete an Advanced Course at least once every three years to remain certified. If it has been more than 3 years since your last class then you need to re-take Basic to remain certified.

Reading assignments to be completed before the first meeting of the class will be e-mailed to you or handed out at book pickup.
