## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS**

<u>Basic</u> – This course is foundational for all courses in Lay Servant Ministries. Participants are encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in their discipleship.

<u>Called to Preach</u> – This Advanced Course is designed for those who have not completed formal preaching training, for pastors seeking a basic refresher course, and for others who are called upon to preach in a pastor's absence. (Required course to become a Certified Lay Speaker)

<u>Opening Ourselves to Grace</u> – This Advanced Course explores the basic practices of Christian faith and life from a Wesleyan perspective. Through video and Bible study the participants will gain insight into Wesley's understanding of spiritual practice and be better able to help their congregations understand the transforming power of grace. (SC Conference approved course)

<u>Loving People and Planet in God's Name</u> – This Advanced Course empowers participants to engage local churches in creation care and environmental justice. They will see this work as the appropriate response of disciples of Jesus Christ to the realities of climate change. And they will grow deeper in their faith through the caring creation of practical and context-specific spiritual practices that mitigate the effects of reckless human consumption. (new course)

<u>Living Our United Methodist Beliefs (Heritage)</u> – This Advanced Course will explore the special gifts of theology, witness, and organization that The United Methodist Church brings to the church universal, how we got where we are today, and how our distinctive emphases are still needed in the 21st-century church. (*Required course to become a Certified Lay Speaker*)

You <u>must</u> participate in all 10 hours of classroom contact time to receive a certificate. Lay Servants must complete an Advanced Course at least once every three years to remain certified.
