Lay Members and Alternate Lay Members to the 2024 Annual Conference were elected at their congregation's Charge Conference in late 2023. Those elections were reported electronically when your Charge Conference Reports were completed.

Registration for the 2024 Annual Conference will be online (www.umcsc.org/ac2024) beginning in mid-February and closing May 27, 2024. Registrations will be verified against the names of those elected and reported on the Charge Conference Reports. Only persons whose names appear on the Charge Conference forms as Lay Members will be recognized as Lay Members of the 2024 Annual Conference. Alternates whose names appear on the Charge Conference forms will be allowed to register in place of the originally elected lay member. (They will need to provide the name of the person they are replacing.)

If you need to change the Lay Member(s) from your charge to the 2024 Annual Conference it must be done with your District Superintendent's permission. Changes must be submitted to the Conference Secretary's office no later than May 27, 2024 using this form.
