Course Descriptions

- **Lay Servant Basic Course** – Foundational for all courses in Lay Servant Ministries. Participants are encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders.
 - **Youth Basic Course** – Participants will learn the reality of the priesthood of all believers and God's call on our lives; the meaning and purpose of spiritual gifts, and the need for a response to God's call.
 - **Leading Worship** – This course focuses on the ministry of the lay servant who either regularly or occasionally leads a group or congregation in worship.
 - **Leading Public Prayer** – People learn to pray by listening to others, so the prayers they hear in church and Sunday school have a large influence on their own prayer lives. It is vital, then, that you are knowledgeable and lead well.
 - **Soul Reset** – This course is a call for the church and all of Jesus' disciples to reset and reorder their lives around spiritual practices; to learn to walk through our difficult seasons with our souls connected to the source of Living Water, so that we don't burn out or break down; then lift one another up and point one another back to Jesus
