- Lay Servant Basic Course Encourages people to recognize and use their spiritual gifts for work in the church, helping each congregation to become an outpost for mission and transformation. Individual sessions guide participants through thoughtful reflection on leading, caring, communicating, and spreading the love of Christ in the world.
- United Methodist Polity Understand the purpose and overall structure of the United Methodist connectional system and the many ways our connection works together to make disciples of Jesus Christ.
- Dancing With Words Helps all church leaders explore storytelling in faith development and acquire basic storytelling skills. Learn how storytelling enhances ministry and explore the use of storytelling in sermons and teaching.
- For the Common Good After identifying their particular gifts, clergy and laypeople will learn how to apply them for the good of their church, their community, and the world.
- Leading Public Prayer People learn to pray by listening to others, so the prayers they hear in church and Sunday school have a large influence on their own prayer lives. It is vital, then, that you are knowledgeable and lead well.
