CLASS SELECTION

Introduction to Lay Ministry: The Basic

<u>Course</u> - This is the required course for all beginners to lay servantry. It also serves as the refresher course for those who wish to be recertified.

<u>Leading Public Prayer:</u> - Praying in public can be daunting, but prayer is something one learns. This course on praying in public will help the participant grow in confidence and skill in public prayer and enrich their personal prayer life.

<u>United Methodist Heritage</u> - This course will explore the special gifts of theology, witness, and organization that the United Methodist church brings to the church universal, how we got where we are today, and how our distinctive emphases are still needed in the 21st-century church.

<u>Accountable Discipleship</u> - This course focuses on the concept of the household of God, scripture as divine revelation, Wesleyan understandings of grace, and the importance of the class leader in the development of the Methodist movement.

<u>Teaching Adults</u> - This course is designed to help provide a basic understanding of the ways in which adults learn and grow.

Justice in Everyday Life - This course takes an in-depth look at the social principles of the United Methodist church; the church's attempt to speak on contemporary issues with which it is confronted today.

<u>Leading in Stewardship</u> - This course helps participants develop a holistic understanding of stewardship.
