

EXAMPLE ONLY:

I. Three Brief Lesson Plans

Create three(3) additional brief session plans to go with this Bible Study. Each session must include the following:

Lesson #: 1

Title: Who is Jesus?

Scripture: John 1:1-18

Purpose: *Ex.* **To explore who Jesus is and some of the more common ideas about the identity of Jesus held in our contextual life.**

Objective: *2-3 outcomes that you hope to accomplish in this session. i.e. "students will be able to...."*

Objective 1: The students will list characteristics of Jesus.

Objective 2: The students will share in small groups what characteristics they experience in their lives.

Write a paragraph about how you would plan to teach this session.

This lesson would be taught in the fellowship hall with tables and chairs. I would work toward a more discussion-based time together; therefore, I would use small groups, question and answering and listing in order to help them discover the characteristics of Jesus in Scripture and also in our lives today. The big question is: how do we see Jesus living in our lives today?
