Disciples in the Marketplace: Seeing Grace at Work

Our working life can be challenging – what is the measure of vocational success? Disciples in the *Marketplace: Seeing Grace at Work* is a new LSM course focusing on discipleship as witness to grace at work. Based on five streaming video conversations with ordinary lay persons, the Disciples in the Marketplace participant's book offers a glimpse into the work lives of ordinary believers who connect the dots between faith and life. Lay leaders are called to create holy conversations around how we practice God's presence on the job. As part of the *See All the People* family of resources, Disciples in the Marketplace offers a fresh understanding of how our ordinary work lives already respond to God's grace for the life of the world. This study also helps leaders nurture the vocational imagination of the 'all-called' (laity) and rediscover together the power of telling our own "disciple in the marketplace" stories. By remembering and recognizing grace at work in our laboring lives (and the lives of others), we deepen, enrich, and expand our capacity to "meet God and share grace" (Omari Booker, Episode One).
