








#### 2024 SCCUWF 52nd Annual Meeting/ Rock Hill

Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me." 2 Corinthians 12:9. God showed me his grace, who cannot serve a God like this. Rev. Elma L. Galbreath stood in the gap for me then, and I am eternally grateful for God sending her. After the service I shared with Nurse Elma how she ministered to me while I was in the hospital back in April through June 1997. Praise God for her, I continue to pray for her, because back then I did not know how to pray for myself. Praise God for divine connection.

South Carolina United Women in Faith is offering a scholarship to future leaders of United Women in Faith. As a supportive community, our desire is to financially assist young women with their higher educational needs.

Each applicant should be given all six forms listed above. The applicant is required to complete the <u>Application for Presidential Scholarship</u> form. If the applicant is in high school, she should have her high school Guidance Counselor complete the appropriate form; if in college, her Dean or Advisor should complete the appropriate form. If employed, her employer should complete the Guidance Counselor form. Letters of recommendation are required from the applicant's local pastor and the president of her local UWF.

In order for an application to be considered, it must be typed or legibly written. **ALL** required materials are due to the chairperson of the Scholarship Committee with a postmark date no later than March 1.

#### SOUTH CAROLINA CONFERENCE UNITED WOMEN in FAITH

#### PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP STANDARDS

- 1. Scholarships are available to women who are members of a South Carolina Conference United Methodist Church.
- 2. Undergraduate and graduate scholarships are awarded to students who have been accepted at an institution of higher learning, which include technical, two-year, or four-year college or university.
- 3. Scholarships for graduate and undergraduate study shall be given annually, based on the availability of funds.
- 4. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the designated college by the Conference Treasurer. One-half of the award will be paid for the first semester, and the other half of the award will be disbursed upon successful completion of the first semester term.
- 5. The scholarship is granted for one year with the privilege of reapplying for an additional year. No more than two SCCUWF Presidential Scholarships will be awarded to any individual.
- Application forms will be available from all District Presidents of the South Carolina
   Conference United Women in Faith, members of the Scholarship Committee, and from the
   conference website, <u>umcsc.org/women</u>. All applications (typed or legibly written) must be
   sent directly to the chairperson of the Scholarship Committee.
- 7. The Conference Scholarship Committee will make the final selection of the recipients.
- 8. No application will be considered unless all requirements are postmarked by the March 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.
- 9. Not all applications will be funded.
- 10. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision.

## SOUTH CAROLINA CONFERENCE UNITED WOMEN in FAITH REQUIREMENTS FOR PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- 1. Scholarships are made available to women who:
  - a. Are members of a South Carolina United Methodist Church.
  - b. Have met all Presidential Scholarship Standards as set by the United Women in Faith of the South Carolina Conference.
  - c. Show active participation in the program and service activities of the church and United Women in Faith (UWF).
  - d. Have a minimum 2.5 GPA in high school or college. Student is responsible for requesting a current official transcript to be sent directly to the chair of the Scholarship Committee from her high school or college. <u>First and second-year college students must also include an official high school transcript.</u>
- 2. Applicant will be evaluated in these three areas: grade point average (GPA), leadership and community involvement, and UWF and church participation.
- 3. A personal letter of introduction with details of activities including leadership, community service and involvement in United Women in Faith and church shall be submitted by the applicant.
- 4. Letters or forms of recommendation are required from the following: (No letters from parents or legal guardians will be accepted.)
  - a. Pastor, Lay Leader, or Youth Leader. Details are requested. See Note #1
  - b. President of the local United Women in Faith's unit or United Women in Faith's
     District Officers. <u>Details are requested</u>. See Note #1


