
A heartfelt thank you goes out to the officers who attended



# INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL TREASURERS

<u>Local treasurers</u>: Submit the completed remittance form and mail, with your check, to your district treasurer.

<u>District treasurers</u>: Complete the paper remittance form or submit via the online remittance portal (preferred) after consolidation the information from all of the local treasurers in your district. If submitting a paper remittance form, mail it with a check to your conference treasurer. Conference treasurers: Enter or consolidate your district remittances using the online remittance portal monthly

(preferred) or quarterly. You should make a remittance to the national office at least four times per year. Mail your check to the national office's PO box with the remittance number in the memo. To give via electronic funds transfer, contact the national Treasurer/CFO.

# **How to Complete the Remittance Form**

### MISSION GIVING—Five Channels of Giving

Mission Giving is the unrestricted giving towards our mission.

- Line 1 Pledge to Mission: Enter total giving. This includes Pledge to Mission and gifts/offerings collected on special occasions. Conferences only should subtract the designated percentage for the conference budget.
- Line 2 Special Mission Recognition (SMR): Insert total from Special Mission Recognition order forms. This form may be sent on its own or attached. On the form, indicate the pin type and amount (\$40, \$60, \$100, \$200, \$500, \$1,000, or \$2,000) for each order. Attach copies of local treasurers' orders.
- Line 3 Gift to Mission (GTM): Enter total from Gift to Mission order forms. Local units order cards from district treasurers. Cards are sent to district treasurers on a revolving basis. Be sure to have many on hand for a speedy reply to requests.
- Line 4 <u>Gift in Memory (GIM)</u>: Enter total from Gift in Memory order forms. Local units order cards from district treasurers. Cards are sent to the district treasurers on a revolving basis.
- Line 5 World Thank Offering (WTO): You may order a World Thank Offering materials on the UWFaith Resources website (https://uwfaithresources.org/).

### DESIGNATED GIVING

Designated Giving is restricted to a particular program or project of UWFaith. A complete list with descriptions is available on the UWFaith Resources website. Please do not send funds for projects that UWFaith no longer supports.

- Lines 6 13 Enter the total giving for each project name. A complete list of programs and projects is updated and posted yearly on the UWFaith Resources website.
- Line 14 Bequests should entered on this line and a copy of the will or other documentation should be sent to the national Treasurer.

### TOTAL REMITTANCE

Enter the check information (payable to, amount, and check number).

**Local treasurers:** Write a check in the amount shown on the "total remittance" line made payable to the district and submit to the district treasurer. Keep a copy for your records.

<u>District treasurers</u>: Write a check in the amount shown on the "total remittance" line made payable to the conference and submit to the conference treasurer. Keep a copy for your records. FORM NOT NEEDED IF SUBMITTED ONLINE

<u>Conference treasurers</u>: Consolidate district remittances on the online Remittance Portal and mail check to the national office's PO Box. Contact the national treasurer if you would like to give via electronic funds transfer.



## **GUIDELINES FOR ADULT CHAPERONES AT S.C. CONFERENCE UNITED WOMEN IN FAITH EVENTS**

I (Print Name)	agree to always comply
with the "Two Adult Rule" so that no adult is ever alone with teen women. When	providing one-on-one
mentoring or consultation with a teen woman, I will keep the room door open at	all times and remain in
plain view of others. I agree to report any suspected child abuse or inappropriate	e behavior between an
adult and minor to the designated United Women in Faith Executive Officer.	

When taking disciplinary action for minor covenant violations becomes necessary, I agree to use non-physical forms of discipline and employ mediation techniques whenever possible. In so doing, I agree to reserve judgment until all the facts have been obtained and the teen woman committing the violation has been allowed to explain her conduct. Any minor violations of the covenant shall be resolved as promptly and amicably as possible. Responsibility for maintaining the covenant rests with each teen woman and the entire group (that is, the adult chaperone and the teen woman she is designated to supervise). Every effort should be made for mediation, reconciliation, and empowerment within the group to resolve the situation and negotiate the consequences of minor covenant violations. The adult chaperone shall facilitate the mediation and allow the entire group to repair the covenant's brokenness.

### MINOR VIOLATIONS OF THE COVENANT ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Excessive noise or disruptive behavior.
- 2. Disrespect for another's person or property.
- 3. Late for curfew (not in her room when curfew begins).
- 4. Breaking curfew (leaving her room after curfew begins).
- 5. Late to scheduled activities, sessions, or meals.
- 6. Uncooperative attitude.

In the case of major violations of the covenant or civil or criminal violations of the law, the adult chaperone shall immediately intervene without consulting with the rest of the group. The parent or guardian shall be notified promptly. Major covenant violations are not immediate grounds for termination of participation and should be decided between the adult chaperone, teen woman, and parent or guardian. Civil or criminal violations of the law are immediate grounds for termination of participation. In the case of termination of participation, the adult chaperone shall notify the designated United Women in Faith National Office executive staff member immediately and inform her of the circumstances.

### MAJOR VIOLATIONS OF THE COVENANT ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Repeated minor violations (more than three of the same or different).
- 2. Damaging, defacing, or destroying property.
- 3. Leaving the site without permission.
- 4. Skipping scheduled activities, sessions, or meals.
- 5. Violent or abusive behavior or language toward another.
- 6. Endangering one's own or another's safety.

# **GROUNDS FOR IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF PARTICIPATION ARE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. Any civil or criminal violation of the law.

- 3. Possession of firearms, weapons, or fireworks.

If another adult leader or chaperone witnesses a violation, she shall immediately refer the matter to the
designated adult chaperone for the teen woman involved. The designated adult chaperone shall take the
necessary steps to ensure proper handling of the situation as outlined above.


