Course Descriptions

- Lay Servant Basic Course Encourages people to recognize and use their spiritual gifts for work in the church, helping each congregation to become an outpost for mission and transformation. Individual sessions guide participants through thoughtful reflection on leading, caring, communicating, and spreading the love of Christ in the world.
- Living Our United Methodist Beliefs Gain an understanding of the distinctive traditions and emphases of The United Methodist Church; become informed about the journey of the people historically knows as Methodists and Evangelical United Brethren, who united in 1968 to form The UMC; develop skills in interpreting United Methodist heritage and emphases to the local church and its members.
- Spiritual Gifts Inventory Helps participants understand spiritual gifts and how the church can use them to fulfill its mission and ministry. Participants will be able to identify their own spiritual gifts.
- Opening Ourselves to Grace Explores the basic practices of Christian faith and life from a Wesleyan perspective by examining John Wesley's understanding of spiritual practice, Bible study, and other helpful resources.
